## **Fear**

- At this time, both Jesus and the disciples were probably afraid. It is okay for us to be afraid too! We should talk to Jesus about our fears.

## **Confusion**

- It would have been confusing for the disciples to have their friend arrested in front of them. Sometimes we get confused too. Jesus is big enough to take this away from us!

## **Anger**

- I don't know about you, but I would have been upset that Jesus was getting arrested (look at Peter in John 18:10-11 – he seemed mad!). But Jesus doesn't want us to be angry, He wants us to trust Him.

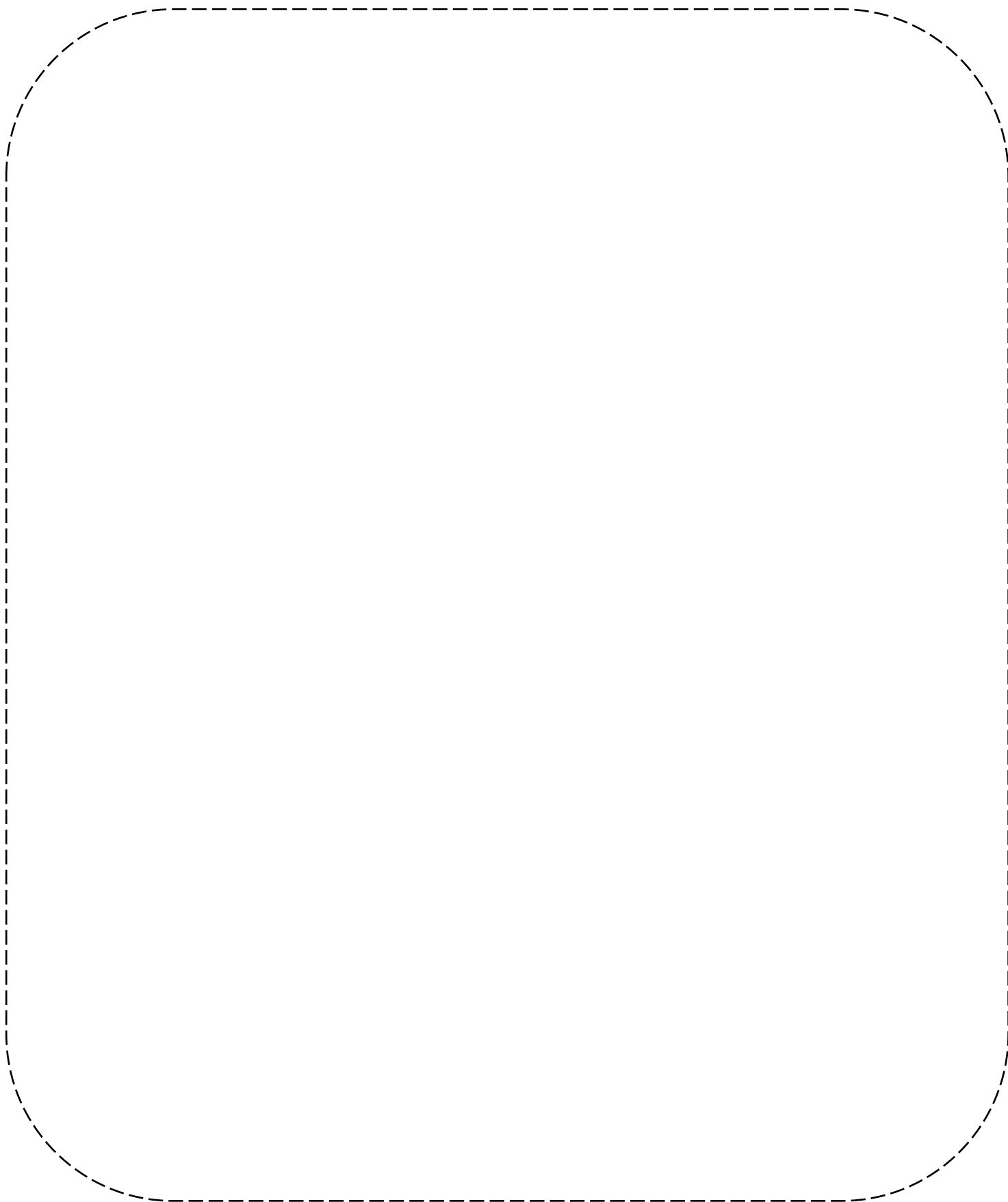
## **Some questions to discuss as a family:**
