The Blame

The Meeting

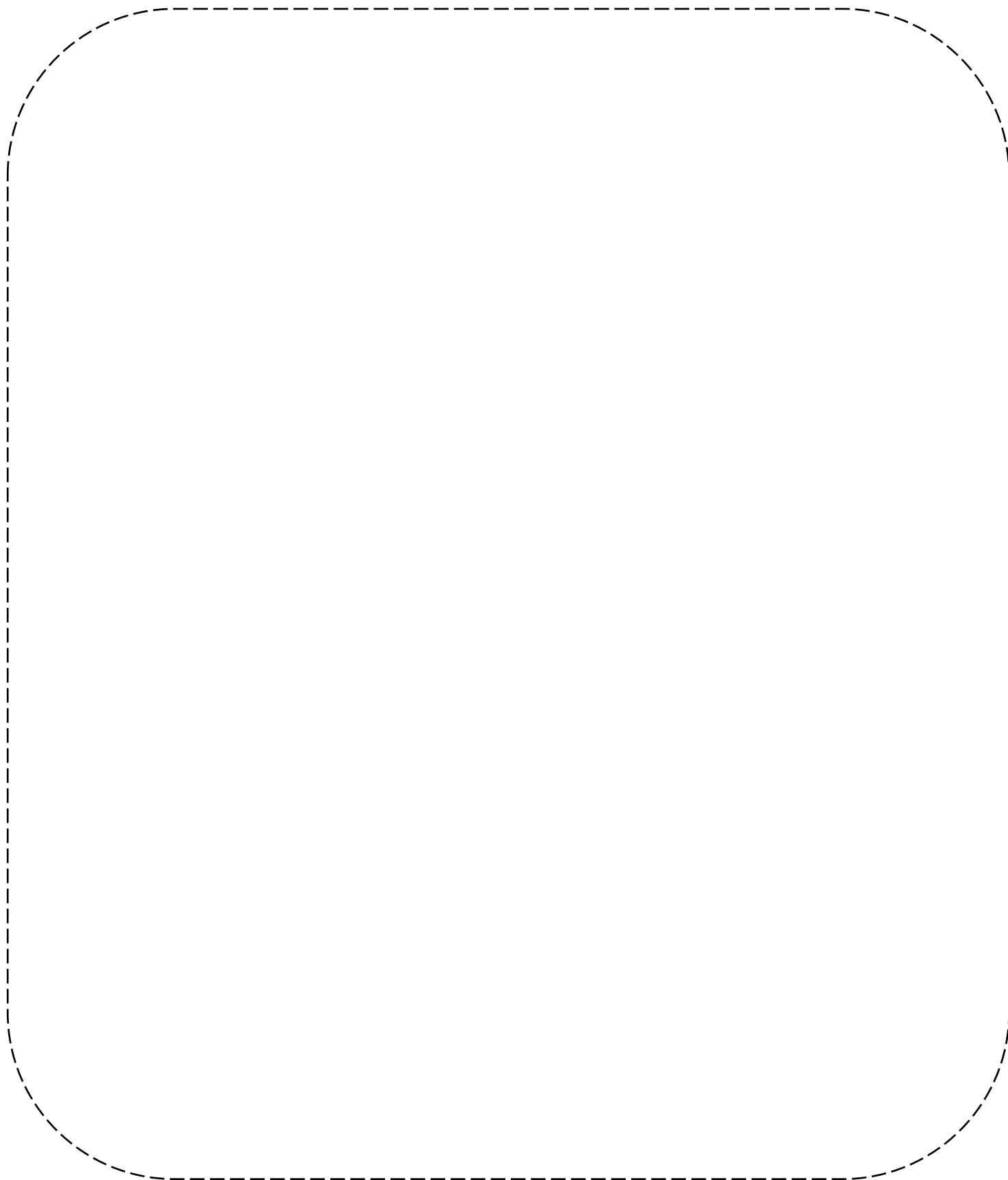
- Jesus and His followers had to prove that He was not guilty! The people could choose to set Jesus free or to set a really bad man free! And they chose the bad man, named Barabbas!
