John 11:25-26 (ICB)

²⁵Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will have life even if he dies. ²⁶And he who lives and believes in me will never die. Martha, do you believe this?”

What is the Resurrection?

- What we call, *the Resurrection*, is when Jesus rose from the dead after He was dead for three days! This is the event that we celebrate with our families at Easter!

Why is Jesus’ Resurrection Important?

- Because this is the biggest, most important part of our faith! If Jesus did not rise to life again, we would not be able to follow Him like we do today!

What Did the Resurrection Do?

- Jesus rising from the dead means that we will never die! We can live with Him forever in Heaven if we believe in Him.

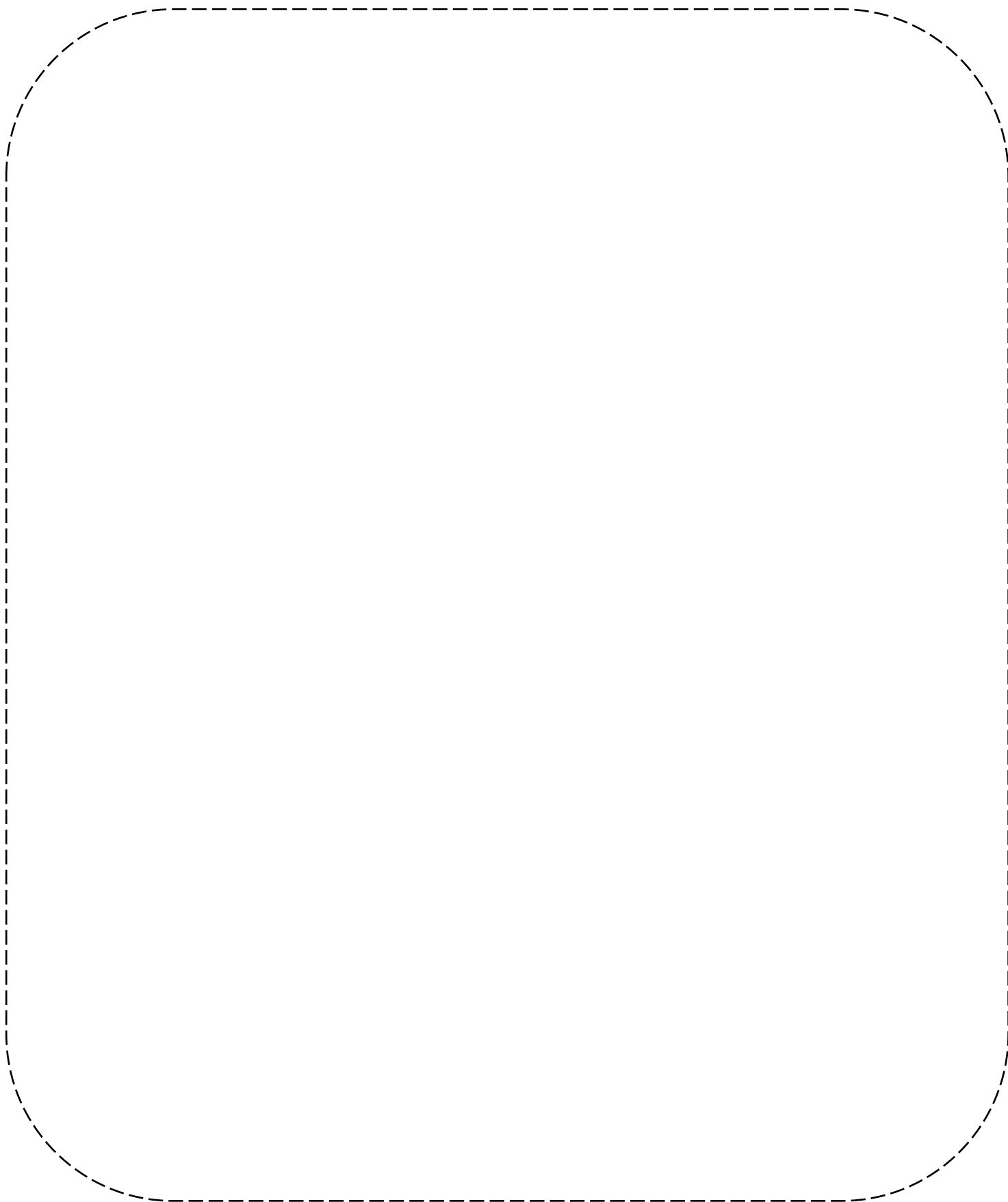
Some questions to discuss as a family:
