- No matter what happens, and no matter how we feel, we can always know that Jesus is there for us; and not only that, but He cares so much about us all!

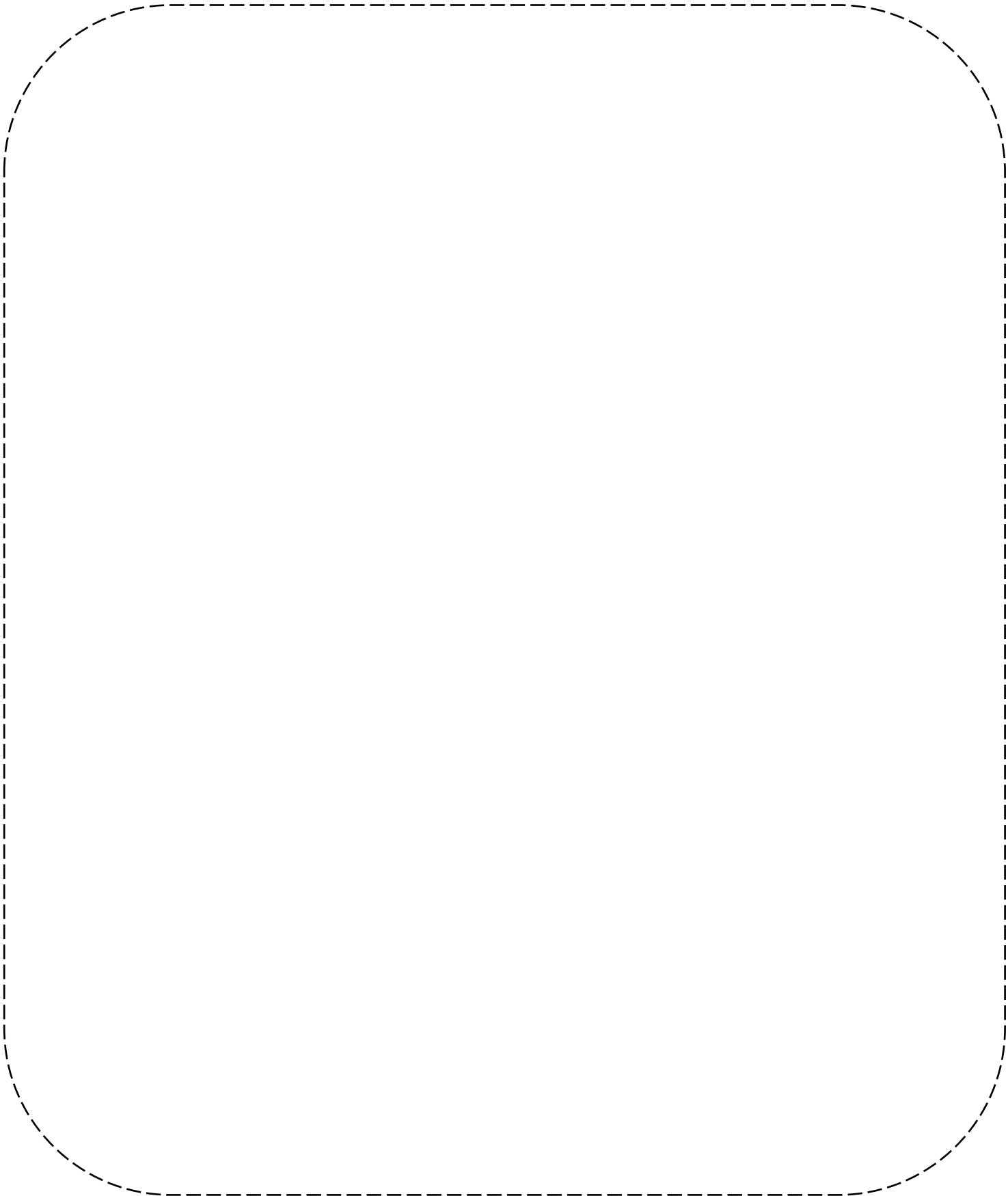
Some questions to discuss as a family:

Trust Challenges!

This week, we talked about the fact that Jesus cares about us!

Keeping this in mind, it is very important that we trust Him in everything that we do!

Below are some trust challenges that you can try together as a family this week to learn more about what it means to trust!

- **Trust Fall** – Have one member of your family fall backwards with their eyes closed while another member of your family catches them!
- **Twin Drawings** – Have one family member draw a picture. Once done, have him/her instruct another family member on how to draw the same picture without ever showing them the picture!
- **Blind Obstacle Course** – Set up a simple obstacle course together as a family! Once this is done, blindfold one family member, and have another family member guide them through the course using just their voice! No touching or handholding allowed! BE CAREFUL THOUGH! This can be very dangerous! Make sure that the blindfolded family member is safe and that they cannot get hurt!
