

## We Tell Others About Jesus



Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

### Overview

**Bible Basis:** Acts 28; Jude 25

**Bible Truth:** *We are the church!*

### Snack Idea

**Supplies:** Something to share – something you bake as a family could work well.

**Say:** Let’s practice sharing as we eat this snack.

**Pray:** Dear Jesus, we are the church. Help us tell others about You. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Practice the Bible truth, *We are the church!*

### Craft

**Supplies:** Megaphone print out, construction/regular paper, tape, scissors, crayons/markers

1. Help kids cut out the megaphone printout.
2. Ask kids to decorate it. Write “Go Tell It!” on the megaphone in large print. It’s best to write it near the side so you can see the words later.
3. Fold down the two small slips near the handle. This helps the handle pop out after taping.
4. Gently curve the paper down so the two ends can meet. Tape them together to create a megaphone shape.
5. Kids can now speak to their handmade megaphone!
6. Talk about how this craft reminds them of the lesson they just learned. How can this remind us to tell others about Jesus? Link this to the Bible Truth of the unit – *We are the church!*



## Activity

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time

### *Charades*

Supplies: None

- Everyone will have a seat.
- One person will come up front and act out an action (doing dishes, sweeping).
- Others will have to guess what he or she is trying to express.
- Repeat the game and let everyone have a turn to act.
- Telling people about Jesus is not only with our words but also with our actions. How we live will give people an understanding of who God is. If we tell people about not lying, we ourselves should not lie to others. If we say something and don't do it or do the opposite of it, people won't listen to what we tell them. To tell people about God, we must live the way that God wants us to.

### *Worth the Effort*

Supplies: Wrapped candies, clean socks

- Everyone will get a candy. The younger ones will get a pair of socks to put on their hands.
- Everyone will try to unwrap the candy, but the older ones will have to use elbows, no hands allowed! The younger ones will use their hands but with the socks on.
- The one who can unwrap the candy first will be the winner.
- Everyone can then eat his or her candy.
- Repeat if desired.
- Telling others about God is not easy, just like trying to unwrap our candies without our hands. In the end, we get to eat our candies and at the end, it's worth it. It can be difficult when we try to show others who God is but God sees our effort and it's worth it.
