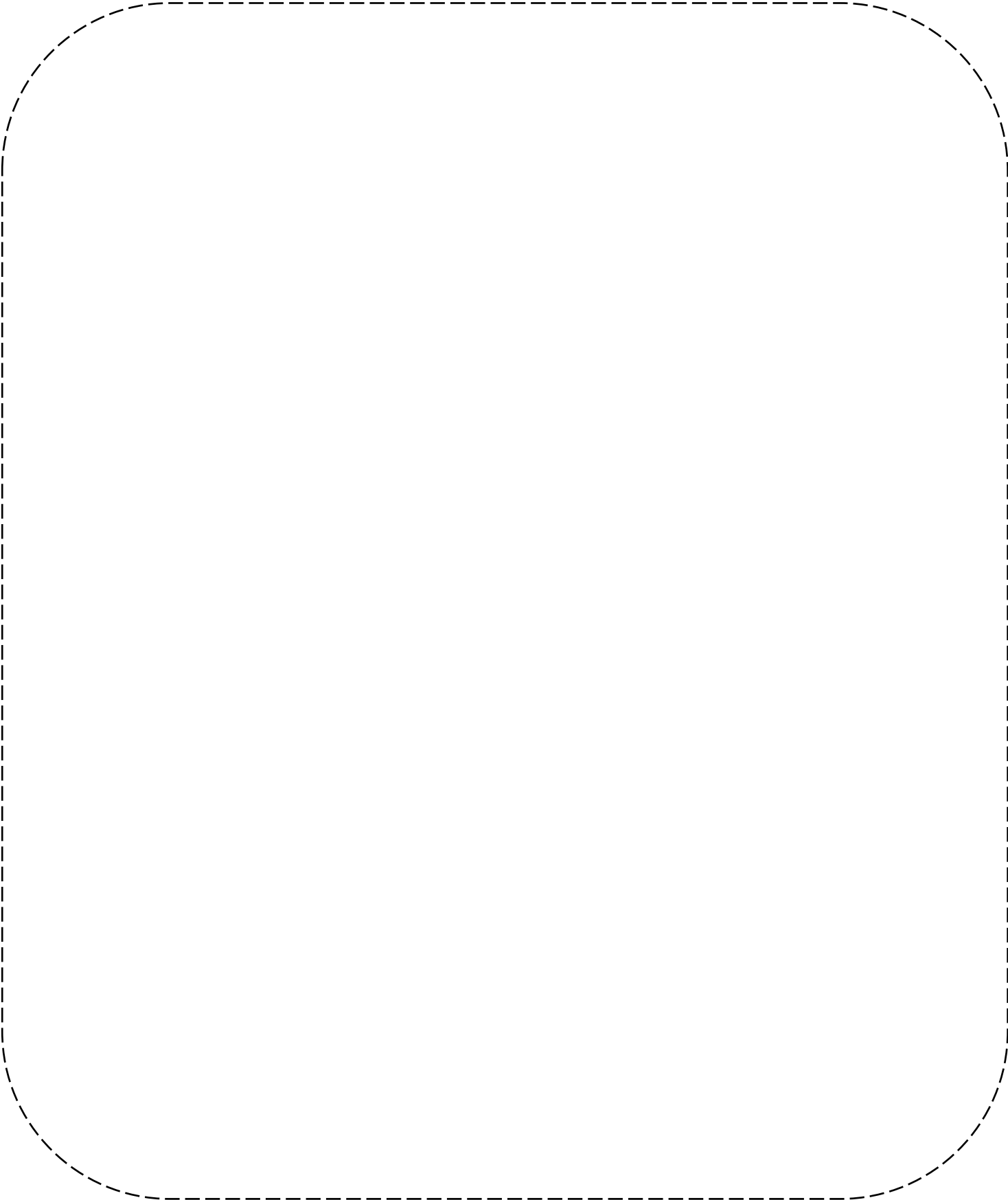
## Some questions to discuss as a family:

- You will be able to trust God more with your sins.
- The Holy Spirit would show you any areas of sin in your lives that need to end.
- The Holy Spirit would help you to stop the sins He showed you yesterday.
