

Little Lost Sheep



Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

Overview:

Bible Basis: Luke 15: 3-7

Bible Truth: Jesus loves me!

Snack Idea: The Lost Sheep

Supplies: Graham cracker or cookie, mini marshmallows, peanut butter (or something sticky), two pretzel sticks or tooth pics, a cheerio

Spread the peanut butter on the cracker, then place the mini marshmallows on top to make a white fluffy sheep. Put the cheerio on as its head and place the pretzels at the bottom, like legs.

Pray: Thank You God, for being so kind to us. And thank You for loving me. Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen. Have your child eat and then say the bible truth, **“Jesus loves me!”**

Craft: God Loves You Sheep Craft

Supplies:

- Printed Pattern
- Card stock
- Crayons or markers
- Glue
- Macaroni Noodles

How to do it:

- Print out the pattern provided below on card stock (because the macaroni is heavy).
- Colour in the pattern.
- Glue on the macaroni noodles.



Activity:

Start by asking a few questions:

- “What was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time: *Hide and Sheep*

- “We are going to play a game called Little Lost Sheep. I will be the shepherd and you are the sheep.”
- The shepherd will hide his/her eyes and count slowly to ten and then start finding the sheep.
- When the shepherd finds his/her sheep, they must go to the “sheep pen” area.
- The sheep must stay in the “sheep pen” until all the sheep are found.
- Tell the sheep to say, “Baa baa.”
- The shepherd says, “I’m so happy to have all my sheep back in the pen. I love my sheep.”
- Ask your child to say the Bible Truth, “***Jesus loves me!***”
