

# Jesus Loves Me



Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

## Overview:

**Bible Basis:** Luke 15:3-7

**Bible Truth:** Jesus loves me!

## Snack Idea: Jesus is Our Good Shepherd

Supplies: Pipe cleaner or bendy straw, cheerios

Bend the pipe cleaner or straw into a shepherd’s hook, then thread the cheerios to make a staff!

**Pray:** Thank You, Jesus, for being my good Shepherd and for loving me. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen. Now, eat and practice the Bible truth, *Jesus loves me!*

## Craft:

### **Supplies:**

- 6 Popsicle Sticks
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pencils, crayons, or markers
- Patterns printed and cut (provided below)

### **How to do it:**

- Before you start, print out the patterns provided below and cut them out.
- Glue the popsicle sticks together following the body pattern below.
- Have the children colour the clothing and sheep pieces once they are cut out.
- Then slip them onto the stick figure.
- Once finished, you can use the figures to act out the parable.
- Have the children tell you what they learned and say the Bible truth, *“Jesus loves me!”*

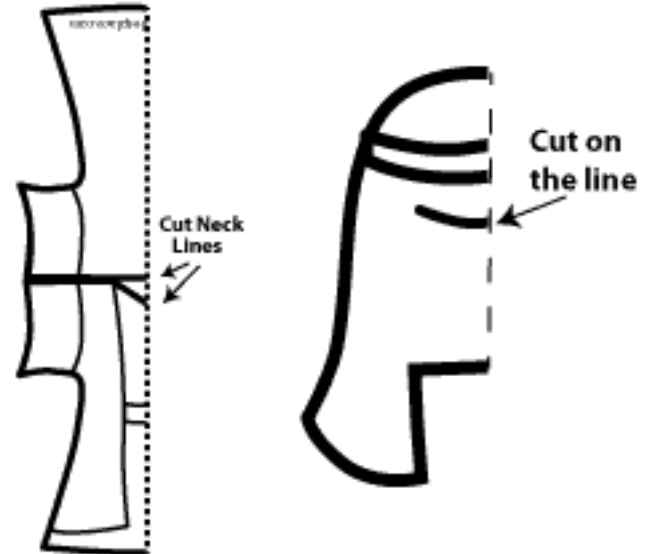
