

Introduction

Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

Overview:

Bible Basis: None for this introduction lesson

Bible Truth: *I have God’s power too!*

Snack Idea - a Super Snack:

Give your child their FAVOURITE kind of snack in your home!

Pray: Thank You, Jesus, for your power. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

Craft - Superhero Gear:

Supplies:

- Construction Paper
- Tape, glue or a stapler
- Colouring utensils
- Other craft supplies you have in your home!

How to do it:

- Help the child(ren) create a superhero outfit!
- A mask, cape, shield, etc.
- Then, practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

Activity:

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time: *Superhero Obstacle Course*

Say: Let’s play a game called – “The Superhero Obstacle Course!”

- For this game, your little superheroes will have to go through an action-hero obstacle course to finally get to the safety of their hideout.
- Use couch cushions, cardboard boxes, sheets, building blocks, paper and any resources available around the house.
- You can even set up some challenges – crawling through a tube, throwing a ball, hula hooping or leaping over tall objects – that the kids have to get through to reach the hideout.
