I must recognize the Sovereignty of God.

- God loves us so much, and He doesn't want us to sin. He hates sin! He will forgive us when we do things that He doesn't like, but we should always work toward not sinning anymore!

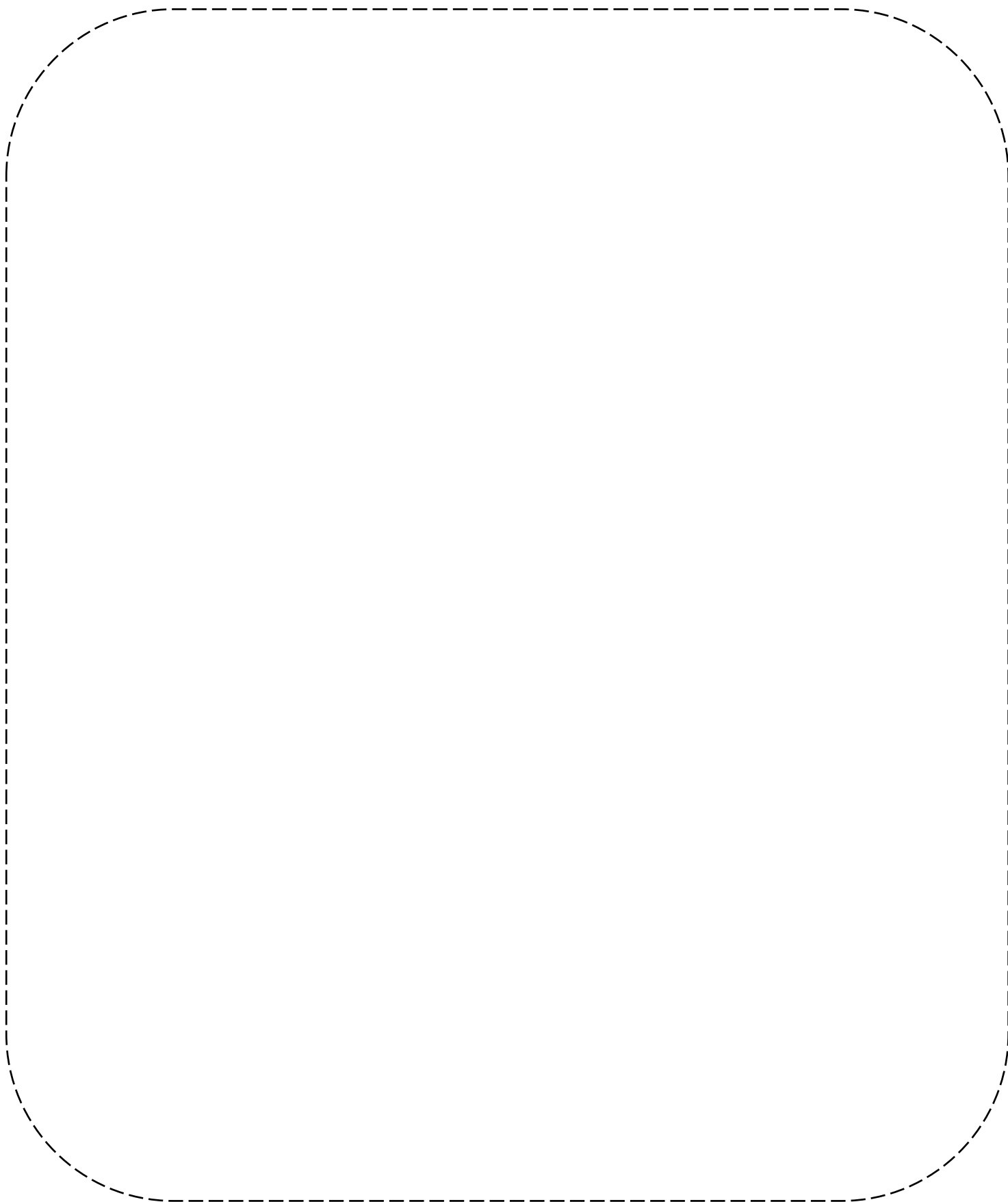
Some questions to discuss as a family:
