Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

Overview

Bible Basis: Esther 2-9

Bible Truth: *I have God’s power too!*

Snack Idea

Supplies: Grape juice, goldfish crackers

Say: God made delicious food for us!

Pray: Thank You, Jesus, that I can trust in you. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen. Then eat and practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

Craft - Queen Esther’s Crown

Supplies:

- Construction paper
- Press-on gems or stickers
- Crayons
- Stapler/glue

How to do it:

- Cut the construction paper in half, the long way (horizontally).
- Then use the scissors to shape the top of the crown however you want!
- Have the child(ren) decorate their crown.
- Then either staple, glue or tape the back of the crown together.
- To finish – practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*



Activity

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time: *Balloon Bop*

Supplies: Balloon, music

- Have the child(ren) stand around the room.
- Toss an inflated balloon to someone in the room. Tell everyone that while the music is playing the balloon has to stay in the air by people bopping it!
- When the music stops, everyone has to try and catch the balloon. Whoever catches it first will tell everyone the Bible truth, ***I have God's power too!***
- Play until every child has had a chance to say the Bible truth.
