

Heroes of the Bible



Daniel

Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple things to help us remember what we learned!”

Overview

Bible Basis: Daniel 6

Bible Truth: *I have God’s power too!*

Snack Idea

Supplies: Orange slices, cookies

Say: God made delicious food for us!

Pray: Thank You, Jesus, for protecting us and giving us your power. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen. Then eat and practice the Bible truth!

Craft - Daniel’s Lion

Supplies:

- Lion face, cut out (or construction paper)
- Crayons/markers/pencil crayons
- Brown tissue paper
- Glue

How to do it:

- Cut out the lion head (or use the paper to make a lion’s head).
- Use the remaining paper to cut circles for the ears.
- If you are using plain construction paper, use a marker to draw on a lion’s face (eyes, nose, mouth and whiskers).
- Cut the brown tissue paper into strips for the mane.
- Use the glue to secure the mane onto the edge of the lion’s face (RAAAWR).
- Then practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*



Activity

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time: *Daniel, the lions are COMING!*

- Have one child stand on the other side of the room (being “Daniel”) with their back turned to the rest of the children.
- Have the rest of the children sneak up behind “Daniel” acting like lions.
- When “Daniel” hears something, they quickly turn around to try and guess who was making all the noise!
- Play until each child has a turn to be “Daniel.”
