

# Heroes of the Bible

Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

### Overview

**Bible Basis:** Genesis 6:5-7:16

**Bible Truth:** *I have God’s power too!*

### Snack Idea

Supplies: Animal crackers, juice and fruit

**Pray:** Thank You, Jesus, for your power. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen. Then EAT.

Practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

### Craft - All the Animals

Supplies:

- Popsicle sticks
- Art supplies
- Example: feathers, markers, googly eyes, etc.
- Glue



How to do it:

- Have the child(ren) decorate their sticks to make two of each animal of their choice.
- Suggestions: birds, lions, giraffes, snakes, etc.
- Then, practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

## **Activity**

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”
