

# Heroes of the Bible



## Josiah

Parents, below are a couple of ideas you can use at home to reinforce and further teach on the Bible story.

“This week we learned a new Bible story. Can you remind me what it was about? Excellent. Let’s do a couple of things to help us remember what we learned!”

### Overview

**Bible Basis:** 1 Chronicles 34:1-35; 19

**Bible Truth:** *I have God’s power too!*

### Snack Idea

Supplies: Cheese, fruit and juice

**Pray:** Thank You, Jesus, for your power. I love You! Thank You for today’s snack. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*

### Craft - Josiah’s Crown

Supplies:

- Construction paper
- Glue
- Cotton Balls
- Stickers

How to do it:

- Use the construction paper to cut out the shape of a crown.
- Glue the ends together so it fits around your child’s head.
- Use the art supplies to decorate their crown however they would like!
- Then, practice the Bible truth, *I have God’s power too!*



## **Activity**

Start by asking a few questions:

- “Who was the Bible story about?”
- “What is the Bible truth?”
- “Can you tell and show me the Bible truth?”

Game Time: *Josiah's Servants!*

Supplies: a “Scroll” with God’s word (roll both ends of a piece of paper to they meet in the middle).

How to play:

- Send your child(ren) back in to clean their room and find the scroll!
- Play as many times as they enjoy.
