- God created us, gave us all we need, and He gave us the Holy Spirit to help guide us.

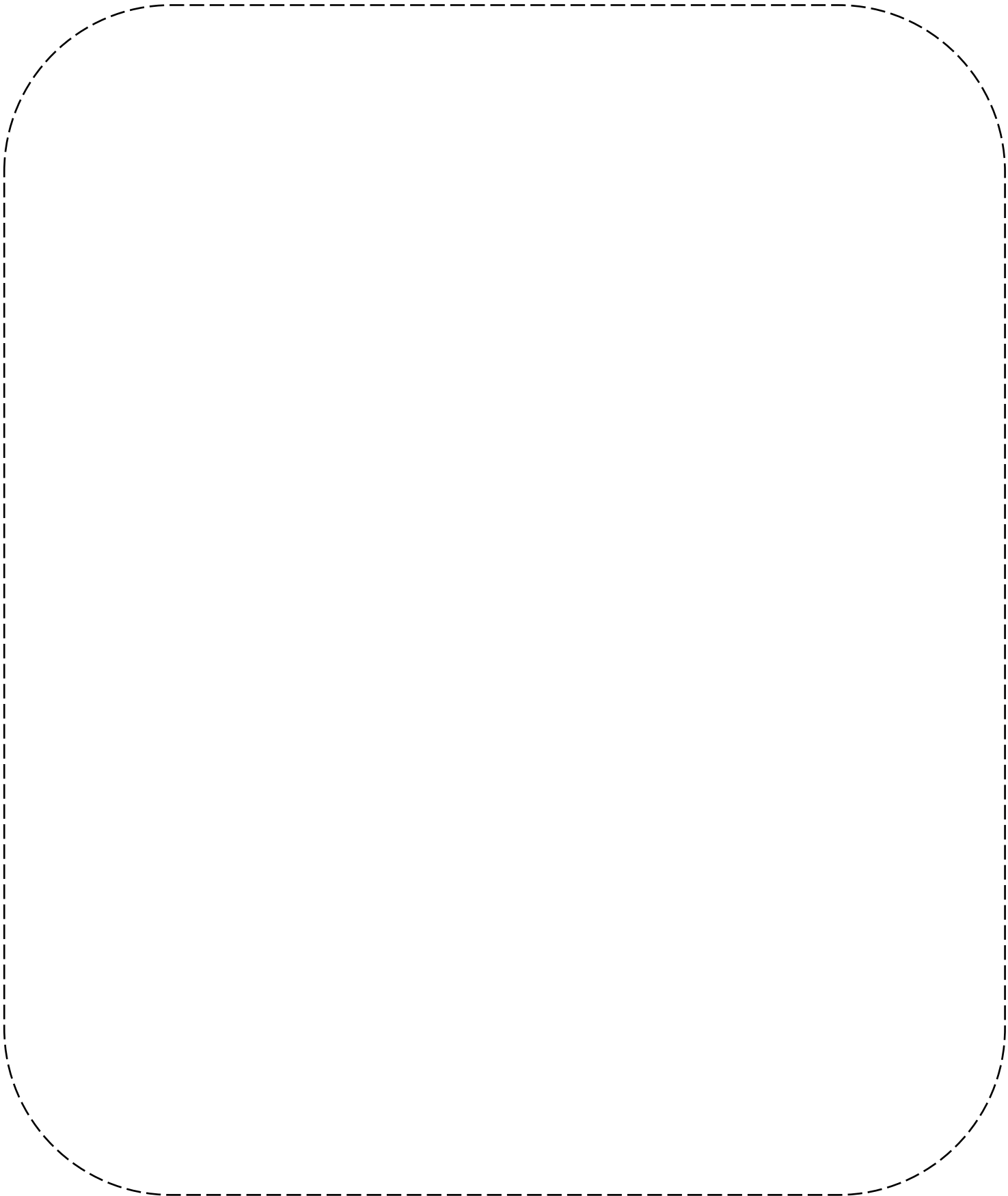
Some questions to discuss as a family:
